

"UNDERSTANDING THE KINGDOM AGENDA"

THE ORDER FOR THE ORDINATION OF AN ELDER

BISHOP SAMUEL MILLER:

Bishop Faulkner, I present unto you this candidate, **Elder-Elect Gloria Sawasawa** to be ordained as an Elder in the Church of our Lord Jesus Christ.

(Following the presentation of the Elder, the Bishop shall say to the people:)

BISHOP ROAN S. FAULKNER:

"Beloved brethren, this candidate who we propose, the Lord willing, this day to ordain as an elder, after due inquiry by the Committee on Credentials and Ordination, we believe that she is lawfully called to this office and ministry and that she is a person meet for the same. But if there be any of you who know any valid reason as to why she ought not to be ordained an elder in this holy ministry to serve the Church of Jesus Christ, let him now come forth in the Name of Jesus Christ, and disclose what the impediment is."

(If no impediment is alleged, then shall the following prayer be said or a spontaneous prayer be given:)

"Lord, our God, in the name of Jesus Christ, who by the Holy Ghost has appointed that elders shall be ordained in Thy Church: Lord, look with mercy upon this Thy servant, now about to be so ordained, and so fill him/her with the truth of Thy Word and doctrine, and adorn him/her with such innocency of life and sincerity of purpose, that by word and good example he/she may faithfully serve Thee in this office, to the glory and honor of Thy Holy Name and the advancement of the cause of Thy Church; in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ and through the power of the Holy Ghost. Amen."

(Then shall be read the Epistle)

⁷ Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power. ⁸ Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ; ⁹ And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ: ¹⁰ To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God, ¹¹ According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:

¹¹ And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers; ¹² For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ: ¹³ Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

(Then the Bishop shall say to the person to be ordained:)





THE ORDER FOR THE ORDINATION OF AN ELDER

Dearly Beloved, you have just listened to the Word of God and have heard of the dignity and the great importance of this office whereunto you are called. Once again, we exhort you, in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you are to be a messenger, watchmen, and steward of the Lord; to teach and to admonish, to feed and provide for the flock of God; to reprove and rebuke when necessary; to seek for the sheep that are gone astray, that they may be brought into the safety of His sheltering fold forever.

Always remember how great this charge is, and how precious the treasure being now committed to your care. Remember that the people are His people; the church is His Church, His Body and His Bride. If it shall happen, that by reason of your negligence in word or in deed, the Church or any member thereof is hurt or hindered, you will have committed a great fault and a grievous injustice to your call. Take heed, therefore, and never cease to labor and to care with all diligence, until you have done all that lieth within you, to bring all such as shall be committed to your charge unto perfect stature of the Man, Christ Jesus.

Forasmuch, then, as your office is both so great in excellency and you so ladened with difficulty and danger, consider how you ought to forsake by the help of God, all worldly cares, and be studious in learning the Scriptures, and in acquiring such knowledge and skills as may help you to declare the living Word of God.

It is our hope that you have weighed and pondered these things within yourself long before now, and that by God's grace, to give yourself fully and totally to this work whereunto it has pleased God to call you. Also, that through your continual life of prayer and fasting, the Holy Ghost may help you to order your own life and the lives of your family according to the rule and doctrine of Christ, that you may grow fuller and stronger in the ministry and be a godly example for the people to follow in all things.

And now, before this congregation assembled, you will declare your promise to observe and to do these things, to perform your duties as a fully ordained minister of the Church of Jesus Christ, in the Name of Jesus Christ and the mission of His Church, you will answer these questions touching upon the same:

THE BISHOP: Do you believe in your heart that you are truly called to this office according to the will

of God by the Holy Ghost and should be ordained as an elder?

THE CANDIDATE: I do so believe.

THE BISHOP: Do you accept the Scriptures as the divinely inspired Word of God and promise to

preach and teach principles and truths that reflect sound doctrine?

THE CANDIDATE: I will do so, the Lord being my helper.

THE BISHOP: Do you promise to be faithful in prayer, fasting, and the reading and studying of the

Word of God?

THE CANDIDATE: I will maintain the spiritual disciplines of prayer, fasting, and be consistent in the reading

and studying of the Word of God.





THE ORDER FOR THE ORDINATION OF AN ELDER

THE BISHOP: Will you make every effort to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace with

your local pastor, leadership team, and the members of your local assembly?

THE CANDIDATE: I will endeavor to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace, the Lord being

my helper.

THE BISHOP: Will you use all diligence to frame and fashion your own life and the life of your family

according to the teaching of Jesus Christ?

THE CANDIDATE: I will, the Lord being my helper.

THE BISHOP: Will you maintain and set forward as much as lieth in you, quietness, peace, and

love among all saints, and especially those that are committed to your charge?

THE CANDIDATE: I will so do, the Lord being my helper.

THE BISHOP: Will you reverently heed them that are over you, and to whom the charge over

you is committed, following with a glad mind and with their godly leadership

and admonition, submitting yourself to their godly judgments?

THE CANDIDATE: I will so do.

(Then shall the Bishop pray while the candidate to be ordained kneels.)

(While the Candidate for ordination is still kneeling, the Bishop shall anoint with oil and the other Bishops or ordained Elders shall lay their hands upon him/her, severally, while the Bishop shall continue to pray. Following the anointing and laying on of hands, the Candidate shall stand, and the Bishop shall present the Bible to him/her saying:)

THE BISHOP:

"Take this as an Ordained Elder in the Church of Jesus Christ and preach the Word without fear or favor, seeking honor that comes from God only, reproving, rebuking, and exhorting with all long-suffering and doctrine; earnestly contending for the faith once delivered to the saints - and serve the Church of God which He has purchased with his own blood. Amen."

BISHOP SAMUEL MILLER:

The Right Reverend, Roan S. Faulkner, Bishop in the Lord's Church, I present to you Elder Dana Rochell, and ask you to lay your hands upon her in the power of the Holy Spirit to in stall her as a Pastor in the One, Holy, Universal Apostolic Church.

THE CHARGE TO THE PASTOR...... Bishop Roan S. Faulkner

Leader: Dearly beloved, we are assembled here in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ and in His presence to install Pastor-Elect Dana Rochell who has heeded the Master's call to become Pastor of Judah Life Christian Center. This is a solemn act which involves mutual obligations therefore, I, Bishop Roan S. Faulkner, call upon you to unite in a covenant of dedication.

(The Pastor-Elect shall stand before the officiating minister who shall address her as follows:)

Leader: Are you willing to take charge of this congregation, as pastor, agreeable

to your declaration at accepting its call?

Pastor: I am now willing.

Leader: Do you conscientiously believe and declare as far as you know in your own heart, that in taking

upon you this charge, you are influenced by a sincere desire to promote the glory of God and the

good of the church?

Pastor: I so believe and declare.

Leader: Do you solemnly promise that, by the assistance of the grace of God, you will live a holy,

consecrated life and endeavor faithfully to discharge all the duties of a pastor to the congregation; and will be careful to maintain a deportment in all respects becoming a minister of the Gospel

of Christ and agreeable to your ordination vows?

Pastor: I do.

Leader: You have been commissioned by God to make disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ by preaching

His Word in season and out of season. The Bible says that you must study to show yourself approved unto God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed so that you might rightly divide

the Word of Truth. Will you continue to give yourself to the diligent studying of God's Word?

Pastor: I will, so help me God.





THE CHARGE TO THE CHURCH Bishop R.S. Faulkner

Leader:

Will the officers and members of Judah Life Christian Center please stand? Brothers and sisters in Christ, being led by the Holy Spirit, Pastor-Elect Dana Rochell has been called to lead you to higher heights and deeper depths in Christ Jesus as the Pastor of Judah Life Christian Center. Therefore, I, Bishop Roan S. Faulkner, am here today to charge you to accept and appreciate the gift that God has sent you in this servant.

Do you, the people of this congregation, continue to profess your readiness to receive this servant of God as your Pastor? Do you solemnly vow that you will give your support to your pastor, Dana Rochell?" Will you give her time for study and for prayer and for her personal life?
